Mark 14:24 “This is my blood of the covenant, which is poured out for many.”

Mary soaked up the precious Blood of her Son with cloths (as in the movie, The Passion of The Christ), representing that she is the living cloth soaking up every precious drop of Blood of her Son. She did not allow a drop to be wasted. She knelt at the foot of the Cross, absorbing every drop of Blood that flowed from Jesus’ wounds. At the moment of the piercing with the sword, Jesus was dead, but Mary was alive, and mystically her Heart was pierced. She desired to die with Jesus and enter His glory in heaven with Him, but the **Father chose for her to remain on earth as the living chalice of Jesus’ Precious Blood.** Through the piercing of her Immaculate Heart, she became the living chalice in which her Son’s Blood was being poured out on the Apostles and the nascent Church.

Only through love in suffering, one with Mary, do we become victim intercessors. Our hearts are pierced as we abandon ourselves totally to the Father's Will and accept all trials, tribulations, persecutions, and sufferings with patience and trust. Libation

2 Timothy 4:6 “As for me, I am already being poured out as a libation, and the time of my departure has come.”

Philippians 2:17 “But even if I am being poured out as a libation over the sacrifice and the offering of your faith, I am glad and rejoice with all of you”

Both verses draw upon the ancient Jewish sacrificial tradition (Numb 15) where wine was poured over an altar as an offering to God. Paul uses this image to describe his life and impending death as a total willing sacrifice to God.
